## **Online Security**



- 64% of companies have experienced web-based attacks
   (NuData Security)
- 62% experienced phishing & social engineering attacks
   (NuData Security)
- **59**% of companies experienced malicious code and botnets (NuData Security)
- There is a hacker attack **every 39 seconds**, affecting one in three Americans each year. (Security Magazine)
- 92% of malware attacks are sent via email (Verizon Breach Investigation report)

- Passwords on all machines





## The Importance of Passwords



- 81% of hacking-related breaches leveraged either stolen and/or weak passwords (Verizon Breach Investigation report)

- The Dropbox breach, which consisted of over 60 million user credentials being stolen, was enabled by an employee reusing a password at work





## Creating Strong Passwords



- Minimum of 10 characters
- String words together that don't belong together
- Add non-letters (symbols, numbers)
- Put numbers in the middle of your password
- Use multiple languages





## Password Management



- Use password managers
- Train staff on proper password management
- Keep track of company passwords
- Require timed password changes
- Everyone in your family needs a password manager, too!

#### **Two-Factor Authentication**



- Password + an additional mechanism to confirm identity
  - email confirmation
  - mobile phone notification
  - text/sms message
  - phone call
- Significantly reduces chance of compromise, but still possible





## Phishing & Spear Phishing

#### Phishing:

method of trying to gather personal information using deceptive emails and websites

#### Spear Phishing:

email-spoofing attack that targets a specific organization or individual, seeking unauthorized access to sensitive information.




Psychological manipulation of people into performing actions or divulging confidential information such as bank information, passwords, etc.

  - Run a phishing simulator campaign








#### **AR/VR Statistics**

## **Augmented Reality**



A technology that superimposes a computer-generated image on a user's view of the real world





## **Augmented Reality**



- Overlays on maps and designs
- Helpful for maintenance work
- Provides safety information







## Virtual Reality



Interactive computer-generated experience taking place within a simulated environment, that incorporates mainly auditory and visual





## Virtual Reality



- Virtual walkthroughs of plans and designs
- Training & safety training

5-15 minute learning segments that are highly targeted and cover one objective.





## **Nano Learning**



- The average viewer loses interest within 10 seconds if bored (entrepeneur)
- Nano learning increases information retention by 20% vs. long-form learning (Elearning Learning)
- Some professional societies now (e.g., CPAs) allow short-form videos to meet CE requirements (Goingconcern)








7. I am so glad a robot/computer cannot possibly do what I do now.












