All applications are kept confidential. Please see application for eligibility details. If your company's 2018 dues have not been paid at the time of judging, your application will not be considered. No exceptions will be made.
- All applications must be received no later than January 31, 2018. Incomplete applications, applications received after the deadline, and applications received without payment will not be considered.
- Applications should be typed for legibility and ease of review. Please use a font size of 11 or larger. Please answer all questions in your own words. UNLESS ATTACHMENTS OR COPIES OF YOUR PROGRAM ARE REQUESTED, THEY WILL NOT BE GRADED.
- 4. Recipients of the 2017 Theodore H. Brodie Distinguished Safety Award will be chosen on the basis of their overall safety program, means of communication and training, and company safety policy. Safety programs are not judged against other safety programs—only against an "ideal" program.
- 5. Please complete this application and submit it with a check for the \$250 application processing fee to the address below.
