



## NIA's Thermal Insulation Inspector Program (TIIP)

TIIP is being developed as a multilevel course designed for those individuals seeking professional mechanical insulation system inspection certification. The course will serve as a thorough introduction to those seeking knowledge and credentials. It will also offer an opportunity to learn more about the inspection process for mechanical insulation systems in new construction, retrofit, and/or maintenance applications. The need for this program was realized after many discussions with members of industry and the engineering community.

### Target audiences for this program include:

- Code officials (commercial or residential market);
- National Association of Corrosion Engineers (NACE) and other educational organizations;
- Engineering and design firms;
- Facility owners and managers;
- General contractors;
- Government (federal, state, and local agencies and facilities);
- Quality control (QC) and quality assurance (QA) firms;
- Mechanical contractors; and
- Mechanical insulation contractors, distributors/fabricators, manufacturers, and others.

### Course levels include:

- Core curriculum;
- Commercial/industrial; and
- Cryogenic.

The course will be taught using a combination of in-classroom instructor training and electronic and hands-on learning. The first course is tentatively scheduled for mid-2018.
