All National Insulation Association (NIA) Contractor, Distributor/Fabricator, Manufacturer (Associate), and Metal Building Laminator member companies are encouraged to apply using the application for their individual category. All applications are kept confidential. Please see application for eligibility details. This program is only open to NIA members in good standing. Your company's membership dues must be paid both at the time of application submission and at the awards presentation. No exceptions will be made.
2. All applications must be received no later than **August 31, 2018**. Incomplete applications, applications received after the deadline, and applications received without payment will not be considered.
3. Applications should be typed for legibility and ease of review. Please use a font size of 11 or larger. Please answer all questions in your own words. **UNLESS ATTACHMENTS OR COPIES OF YOUR PROGRAM ARE REQUESTED, THEY WILL NOT BE GRADED.**
4. Recipients of the 2018 Theodore H. Brodie Distinguished Safety Award will be chosen on the basis of their overall safety program, means of communication and training, and company safety policy. Safety programs are not judged against other safety programs—only against an “ideal” program.
5. Please complete this application and submit it with a check for the \$250 application processing fee to the address below. Companies applying for the first time receive a discount of 50% and should send a check for \$125. All checks should be made payable to “National Insulation Association,” not to Auman, Mahan & Furry.
