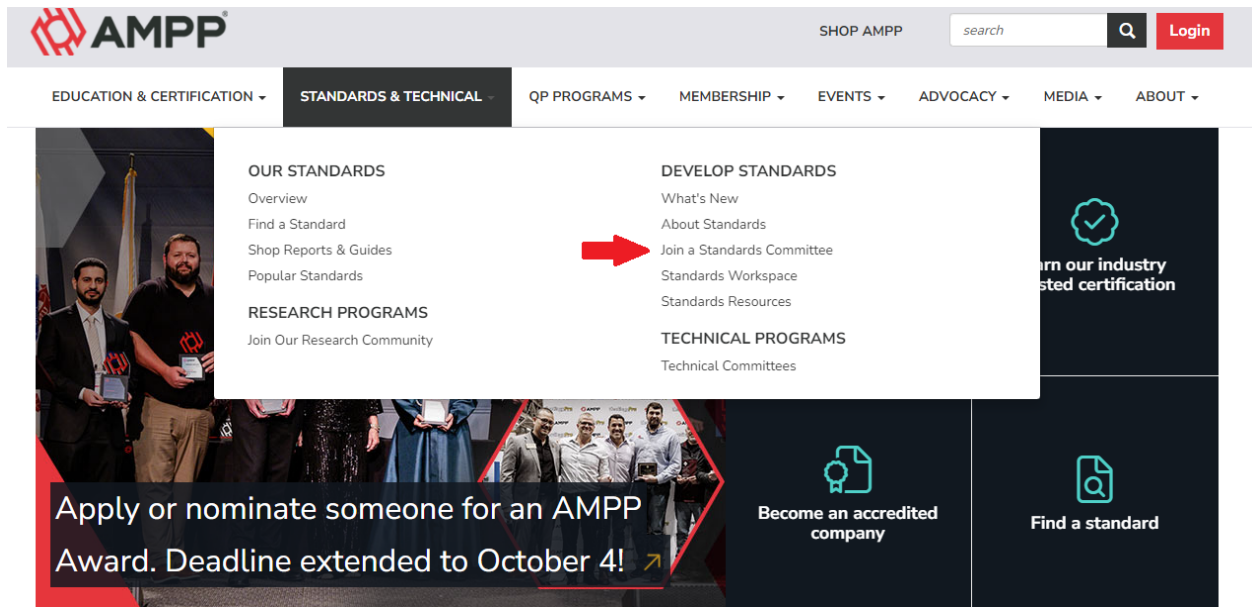





Joining the AMPP/NIA Joint Standards Committee 27 (SC 27), Mechanical Insulation

You're welcome to join SC 27 or any other committee of interest. To join a committee, go to the AMPP website (www.ampp.org), click on the Standards and Technical dropdown menu and select "Join a Standards Committee". The "Join a Standards Committee" landing page lists all of the Standards Committees along with their scopes. The system may ask you to log in and if you don't already have a username, it will require you to create an AMPP profile.



Scroll down to the committee and click the join button next to the committee(s) of interest.

		Develops and maintains standards, guides, and reports related to materials protection and performance in carbon capture, utilization, and storage and in alternative fuel and energy storage technologies including hydrogen, biofuels, non-fossil and low-carbon fuels, thermal and chemical energy storage, and related technologies.
	SC 27	Mechanical Insulation Develops and maintains standards, guides, and reports related to mechanical insulation for industrial, commercial, marine, or consumer application. This includes mechanical insulation systems encompassing thermal, acoustical, and personnel safety requirements in: mechanical piping and equipment for hot and cold applications; heating, venting, and air conditioning (HVAC) applications, refrigeration and other low-temperature piping and equipment applications, and metal building insulation. The following topics are not in the scope of this committee: corrosion under insulation, fireproofing other than thermal insulation used as fire protection, insulative coatings, fiber-reinforced polymer (FRP) in protective and structural applications, cathodic protection of insulated assets, pipeline protection, linings, and immersion service and subsea insulation. This is a joint committee of AMPP: Association for Materials Protection and Performance and NIA: National Insulation Association.

Once you have completed the process and joined an SC, you will receive notifications of meetings and be able to contribute and comment on standards ballots.
