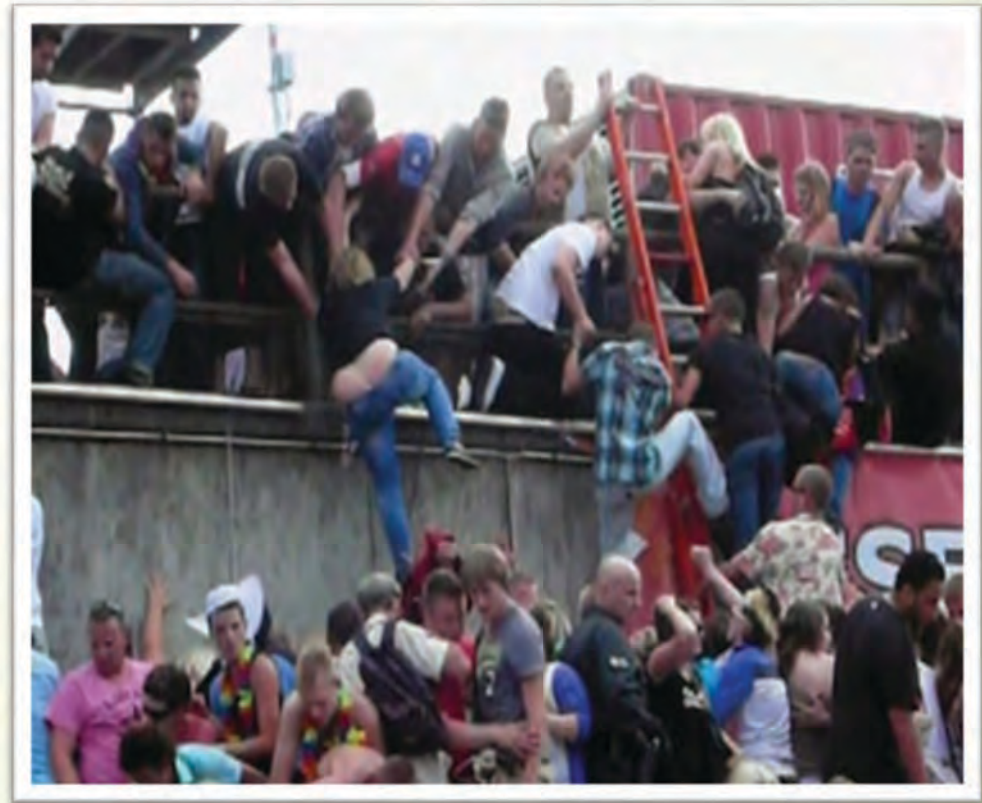

- No Insurance coverage?

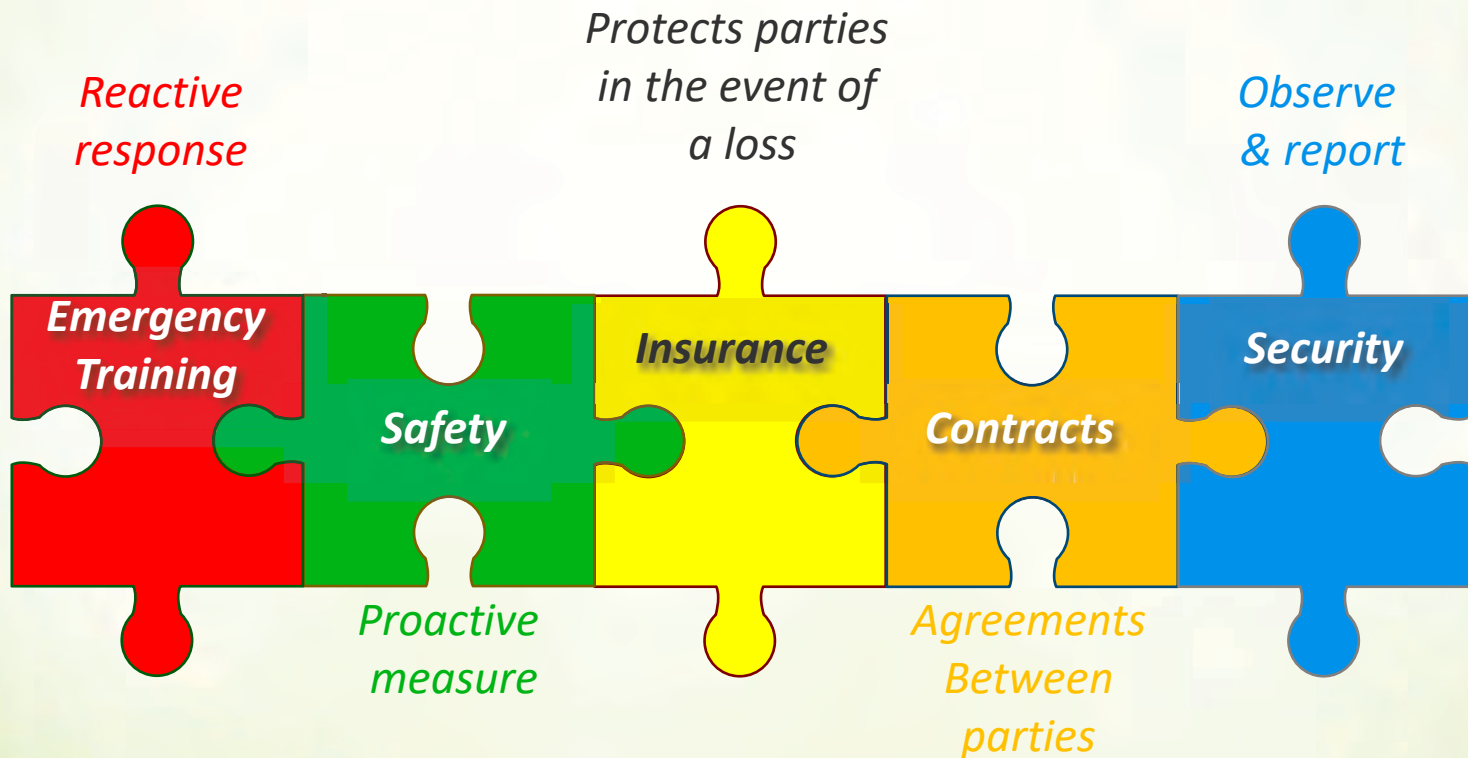

5 elements of risk planning...



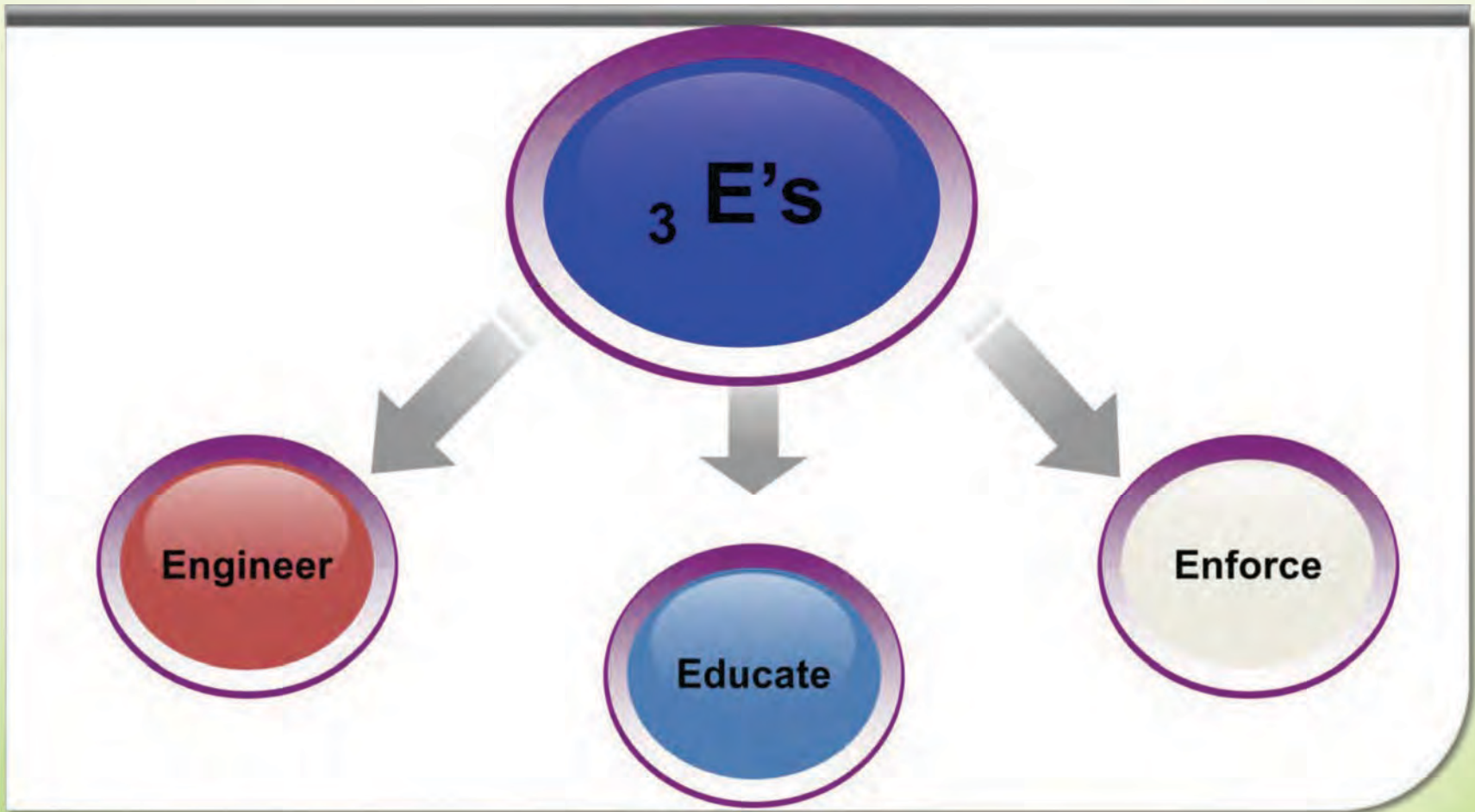


Best approach?

WHY SHOULD YOU CARE?



- Two words to live by:

—Known

—Foreseeable

Duty & Degree of Care

- Everything “reasonably practical” done to protect safety & health
- Standard of care breached by act or omission
 - assessed by degrees of negligence
 - Malice: intent to cause harm
 - *Willful misconduct: deliberate disregard*
 - *Gross negligence: reckless indifference*
 - Negligence: failure to act reasonably
