The Bahamian dollar and U.S. dollar are both accepted interchangeably on all islands. Visa, Mastercard, American Express, and most debit cards are also widely accepted throughout Nassau Paradise Island.

Don't worry about electronics no adaptors required Electrical outlets in the Bahamas are compatible with all American devices.

Transportation No need to rent a car the hotel is only 15 minutes away. Taxis take cash only, so please make sure to get cash before ordering a taxi. Uber and Lyft are not

available on the island.

Gratuities are included All restaurants and bars at Baha Mar will automatically add a 15% gratuity to the final bill.

NIA'S GOLF TOURNAMENT

The Royal Blue Golf Course is a Jack Nicklaus Signature Golf Course with rolling fairways, moonscapes, and native landscapes. The course features dramatic views of the ocean on the front 9 and forested panoramas on the second half. The course is located on property and is less than a 5-minute drive from the hotel. The hotel provides a complimentary resort shuttle to/from the hotel to the golf course.

The 18-hole scramble will have a 12:30 p.m. shotgun start. Gather your industry colleagues and friends for an afternoon of networking and friendly competition!
